



Daycare and Family Are Targets of Injured Baby Investigation

A baby in intensive care with severe -brain injury is holding on, as authorities investigate his family and his day care.

Doctors say one-year-old Nathan Molineux was either severly -shaken, or received a strong blow to the head.

Nathan's father says he dropped his two children off at a licensed day care in Park City Friday morning.

A few hours later, he was told his baby stopped -breathing.

The Summit County Sheriff's Department is investigating the daycare, and the baby's family, to determine what happened.

As standard procedure, the Division of Child and Family Services... -removed the baby's older brother from the home during the investigation.

The care provider told investigators the boy woke up from a nap with an unusual -cry and then appeared not to breath.
