■ Police Investigating Possible Abuse of Baby: <u>Listen to</u> **Audio**

(Park City-AP) -- A one-year old is in intensive care with a severe brain injury and police are trying to figure out what happened.

James Molineux says he dropped his two children off at a Park City day care Friday morning and by 11 A-M he was called to the hospital because his son wasn't breathing.

Doctors say the baby was either severely shaken or received a strong blow to the head.

Summit County Sheriff's deputies are investigating the licensed home day care.

They are also investigating the boy's family.

The Division of Child and Family Services took the baby's three-year old brother into custody as standard procedure in possible abuse cases.

The day care has not returned calls.

The family says the baby might be paralyzed if he survives.

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
